Cancellations made after the course has begun will not be eligible for a refund, unless we have 10 or more students enrolled in the course, in which case you will receive a partial refund based on the percentage of the course that has been completed, less a \$50 administration fee.

In the unlikely event that a course meeting date is changed due to instructor illness, inclement weather, or other extenuating circumstances, participants are expected to attend the workshop on the re-scheduled date.

In the event that we do not have enough registered participants to meet our minimum-student requirement, we will cancel the course. In the event of such a cancellation, we will issue a full refund to all registered participants.

## **Directions to course sites:**

### **Conference Room, Bristol Town Hall**

The Bristol Town Hall is located in the center of downtown Bristol where Vermont Route 116 and South Street meet. The conference room is located downstairs and has been recently and beautifully renovated. The hall is known locally as *Holley Hall*. There is ample parking on the Town Green and South Street. The entry is located on the east side of the building. Universal access is located on the north side of the building.

### **The Vermont Family Forests office**

The VFF office is located on the green in Bristol. At the traffic light in Bristol (there is only one), turn onto North Street and take your first left onto Park Place. Drive to the end of the green and park. The VFF office is located in The Old High School, a large white building at the end of Park Place. Enter the front door, turn left, and go through the door with the VFF sign. Our office is at the top of the stairs. Our phone number is: 802 453-7728.

### **The Waterworks**

From the traffic light in Bristol, follow North St for approximately  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile until you reach Plank Road (on your left). Turn onto Plank Road and check odometer. You'll remain on Plank Road through 2 intersections (Burpee Road at .8 miles and Sawyer Road at 1.7 miles). Plank Road will sweep to the right then make a sharp turn to the left over Norton Brook. The parking area for the Waterworks Property is on the right just before that sharp turn. (Total driving distance along Plank Road is 3.3 miles.)
