Cancellations made less than two weeks prior to the workshop will not be eligible for refund, unless we have someone on a waiting list who can fill your space, in which case you will receive a full refund, less a \$50 administration fee. **Cancellations made after the course has begun will not be eligible for a refund**, unless we have 10 or more students enrolled in the course, in which case you will receive a partial refund based on the percentage of the course that has been completed, less a \$50 administration fee.

In the unlikely event that a course meeting date is changed due to instructor illness, inclement weather, or other extenuating circumstances, participants are expected to attend the workshop on the re-scheduled date.

In the event that we do not have enough registered participants to meet our minimum-student requirement, we will cancel the course. In the event of such a cancellation, we will issue a full refund to all registered participants.

Using leaves, bark, buds, form, and habitat to identify trees in summer
Camel's Hump State Forest in Buel's Gore

Saturday, July 22 (Back-up date Sunday, July 23)

8 AM to 11 AM, **meet at the parking lot for Sycamore Park where Route 116 crosses the New Haven River in Bristol**
Using leaves, bark, fruit, form, and habitat to identify trees in summer
Introduce some useful guides
Sycamore Park & The Watershed Center in Bristol

Saturday, August 19, (Back-up date, Sunday, August 20)

8 AM to 11 AM, **meet at the parking area for Snake Mountain in Addison on Mountain Road just north of the junction with Wilmarth Road**
Using leaves, bark, fruit, form, and habitat to identify trees in summer
Snake Mountain & vicinity in Addison

Saturday, October 7 (Back-up date Sunday, October 8)

8 AM to 11 AM, **meet at the McDonalds in Fair Haven on Route 22A just south of Route 4**
Using leaves, bark, fruit, form, and habitat to identify trees in early fall
Southern Valley Species and perhaps some other interesting critters
The Nature Conservancy's Buckner Preserve in West Haven

Saturday, October 28 (Back-up date Sunday, October 29)

8 AM to 11 AM, **meet at the parking lot for the Long Trail on Route 73 in Goshen**
Using needles, bark, buds, form, and habitat to identify trees after leaf drop
Higher Elevation Species
Green Mountain National Forest along Long Trail in Goshen

Saturday, November 11 (Back-up date Sunday, November 12)

8 AM to 11 AM, **meet at the goose viewing area of Dead Creek WMA, Rte 17 in Addison**
Using bark, buds, form, and habitat to identify trees after leaf drop
Valley Species
Dead Creek Wildlife Management Area
Continue a lifetime of tree (& critter) ID and stewardship
