Start Time and Directions to Site

Classes start promptly at 8:00am. Directions to the training site are listed on our website events page, http://www.familyforests.org/public-education/events.shtml. Please let us know if you do not have internet access to obtain these directions.

Bad Weather

Classes are held in **most** weather conditions, but will be postponed in extreme conditions. If weather seems threatening, participants should call the VFF office (802 453-7728) early in the morning of the workshop. A recording will let you know if the workshop is postponed or cancelled. If there is no such recording, the workshop is proceeding as scheduled.

We schedule a rain date for most training sessions. Please be sure to book off the rain date as well as the actual course date.

In the highly unlikely event that both the regularly scheduled workshop and the rain date workshop are cancelled, you may either apply your registration fee to another GOL training course offered through Vermont Family Forests, or you may receive a full refund.

Refund Policy

We require payment in full upon registration. You may cancel your registration up to two weeks prior to the workshop date and receive a full refund, less a \$50 administration fee.

Cancellations made less than two weeks prior to the workshop will not be eligible for refund, unless we have someone on a waiting list who can fill your space, in which case you will receive a full refund, less a \$50 administration fee. If a workshop is postponed due to rain, participants are expected to attend the workshop on the scheduled rain date.

In the event that we do not have enough registered participants to cover workshop costs, we will cancel the workshop. In the event of such a cancellation, we will issue a full refund to all registered participants.
